OPM rejects these transactions based on the following: "If nature of action (1) is other than 001 or 002 then nature of action (2) must be spaces".</p> <p>Resolution: The CPDF Dynamics Procedure has been modified and programmed to handle dual actions. The temporary correction was removed from the code when the patch was delivered. Customer has reported after P53 implementation that the RTD actions are failing again. The temporary correction has been reapplied. CPMS is writing new requirements to prevent multiple Non-Pay actions from processing without intervening return to duty action. Remedy 16943	<p>Summary: Tenure 1 employee shows twice in the Round 2 processing.</p> <p>Resolution: Modified round 2 processing to not rely solely on actions table. It always came back to someone else--maybe even someone who had something done to them during round 1, but who was not released to round 2. 2. 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Remedy 16947	<p>Summary: The Converted Pattern Wizard Rating in the RIF Manager/Tools/SQL is changing appraisal information when it should not. It should only change those records where there is no converted rating currently in the employee record. When processing the Converted Pattern Wizard Rating the user is prompted to fill in the pattern and converted rating. After filling in the screens the SQL is processed against the database. If there are employee records that need to be updated, the SQL is improperly changing the pattern if they have a converted rating that matches the converted rating identified in the SQL.</p> <p>Resolution: Modified round 2 processing to not rely solely on actions table. The following items were addressed in this build.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Corrected where the Quit button was not allowing round 2 to be resumed with current person. Remedy 17500	<p>Summary: The 4th Estate Agencies did not get the "MIL TO CIV CONVERSION" DDF. Navy, Army and AF Local National also did not get the DDF under the LN Personnel responsibility. The edit did not trigger under CIVDOD Personnel responsibility for NGB, AR, NV, AF LN and AR and AF NAF. Edit did not trigger under NAF Personnel for AR and AF NAF.</p> <p>Note: Partial fix. There is an open issue where the business rule "if Mil to Civ field equals Y then FY Conv Credit is a required field". If the "FY Conv Credit" is blank, then the system, upon validation of the position, should generate the following edit: "FY Conv Credit is blank". This is currently not working for DoDEA.</p> <p>Resolution: Added business rules so that everyone will do the checks for "MIL TO CIV CONVERSION". Remedy 17560	<p>Summary: Completed Pages 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the RPA and attempted to update Human Resources (HR) for a 571/Conv to Excepted Appt Not to Exceed (NTE) 01-MAR-2005. System is generating the following reject: "APP-GHR-38335: IF Pay Basis is PA, Total Salary must be equal to the addition of Adjusted Basic Pay and Other Pay". The employee is receiving a Retention Allowance. The salaries are all correct on Page 2 of the RPA. (Note: There is no difference in the salaries for an AD-03 step 50 and an AD-05 step 50.)</p> <p>Resolution: Modified code to add other pay amount to the Total Salary for 'AD' Pay Plan and for 'PA' Pay Basis. The errors are no longer appearing when processing conversions to the same or different positions for employees on retention allowances.</p>	Navy	Pay

Remedy 17600	<p>Summary: Civilian Living Quarters Allowance (LQA) is being saved to the Defense Civilian Personnel Data System (DCPDS) without a Last Action Code. In addition, it appears that none of the other business rules from Change Request Transmittal (CRT) 03-8292-DoD were applied to Civilian (LQA).</p> <p>Resolution: The fix for CRT 03-8292-DoD was delivered by Oracle; however, one of the elements listed in the CRT 'Civ LQA' is custom code. The edits mentioned in the CRT did not get applied to this element. Modified the code to apply the edits (Last Action Code Required for Foreign Allowances) to the 'Civ LQA' element.</p>	CPMS	Pay
