MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDING OFFICERS OF MILITARY DEPARTMENTS AND
DOD COMPONENT INSTALLATIONS IN THE MONMOUTH,
NEW JERSEY AND BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY WAGE
AREAS

SUBJECT: Abolishment of the Monmouth, New Jersey Nonappropriated Fund (NAF)
Wage Area (#089)

In accordance with the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) interim rule published in the Federal Register (Volume 76, Number 165) dated August 25, 2011, the Monmouth, New Jersey NAF Federal Wage System (FWS) wage area has been abolished, effective August 25, 2011.

Pending final confirmation in the Federal Register (Final Rule), Monmouth County is redefined as an area of application to the Burlington, New Jersey NAF FWS wage area. FWS employees remaining in the Monmouth wage area will be transferred to the #271 Burlington, New Jersey (NY) wage area schedule on the first day of the first applicable pay period beginning on or after October 15, 2011. Please note that pay retention provisions may apply as specified in S9-4, Operating Manual, Federal Wage System, Nonappropriated Fund.

Finally, new NAF wage schedules for the Burlington wage area, resulting from the August 2011 prevailing rate survey, will be issued in the near future. The new schedules will be effective on October 15, 2011.
