The Departments of Labor and Defense are partnering to provide information about a wide range of resources and services that are available to BRAC-impacted workers. These include:

- **One-Stop Career Centers** are single points of access for local, state, and national employment information, training, and related supportive services. - **Occupational Information Network** (<http://online.onetcenter.org>) enables job seekers to easily identify occupations of interest, analyze their readiness for particular occupations, and create resumes to generate employer interest.
- **Military Spouse Resource Center** ([www.careeronestop.org/militaryspouse](http://www.careeronestop.org/militaryspouse)) provides military spouses the best available tools to aid in their search for employment, education, and other relevant community resources (e.g., child care and transportation).
- **National Emergency Grants** enable state governments to expand services in response to significant worker dislocations due to BRAC.
