CRT 05-39324-DoD	<p><b>Summary:</b> New data element Calculation Pay Table Is being created to store the pay table number used in the pay calculation process that determines the employee's pay. This data element is stored in Assignment Extra Information/US Federal Assignment RPA DDF. There is no change in previous requirements as to when the Pay Table ID or the Retained Pay Table Id is populated on the Pay500. This CRT changes the business rules as to what data is flowed in the Pay Table ID (record position 342-345) and Retained Pay Table ID (record position 346-349). These business rules are listed in the CRT, paragraphs 1a, 1b and 1c. Data comparison using the effective date (RPA or direct update) will be done after the changed data has been updated in the assignment record (e.g. Calculation Pay Table has been updated with the new value). The Calculation Pay Table is being updated for all records and is also updated regardless if the effective date of change is prior to 1 May 2005, which is the date the FWFA was implemented, so there may or may not be a date in Calculation Pay Table.</p> <p>Modification to CSU.</p> <p>a.
