| 03-9984-DoD | <p>By-Pass Sever-side validation.</p> <p>Summary: The 11i application software introduced new data integrity routines known as Server Side Validation (SSV) to verify input. This validation occurs on the background processing such as batch loading and interface feeds. In addition, validation occurs on the front-end (in the Professional User Interface) when a change is made to a record, regardless of whether or not the user is updating the invalid data item or the record which contains the invalid data item. As a result of these new routines, some data items are seemingly invalid and no action can be taken to update certain employee records. For example, Agencies must submit a request for a manual workaround to insure an employee will be properly paid. Thus SSV has caused the number of requests for manual payroll workaround to increase dramatically. The reasons for this invalid data are currently being researched.</p> <p>Resolution: As short term solution CPMS has requested that LMSI change the core API to by-pass the SSV validation. Once the long-term solutions have been implemented, CPMS will request that SSV validation be turned back on</p> | CPMS | System Fundamentals |
