SUBJECT: Pacific Northwest Regional Power Rate Schedule (AC-A801)

In accordance with DoD Instruction 5120.39 and Public Law 97-257, the attached schedule of wages is effective June 5, 2011. The 2011-2012 pay freeze prohibits statutory pay adjustments for most Federal civilian employees. This extends to the employees in the jobs listed on the attached wage schedule at the following hydroelectric power plants operated by the North Pacific Division, Corps of Engineers:

PREMIUM PAY

1. Overtime - Overtime will be paid at the rate of double time for hours worked in excess of eight in one day or forty in one week.
2. Holiday Pay - Hours of work performed on a holiday will be paid at the rate of triple time for the basic work requirement. Work on holidays in excess of the basic work requirement will be paid the regular overtime rate of double time.
3. Sunday Pay - None.
4. Shift Differential - None.

Pacific Northwest Regional Power Rate Schedule (*Premium Pay Continued*)

5. Overheight Pay - Overheight pay will be paid at the rate of double time for actual hours worked, paid in minimum increments of one full hour. (See Conditions for Payment).
6. Spray Booth Operation - None.
7. Sandblasting - None.
8. Painters Performing Work in an Energized Substation - None.
9. Carpenters Working Near Energized High-Voltage (600 volts or higher) - Carpenters will receive the T/C Level I rate of pay for actual hours worked, paid in minimum increments of one full hour, when erecting structures within 10 feet of exposed energized high-voltage parts.
10. Firefighting Pay - Firefighting pay will be paid at the rate of an additional 25% of the base hourly rate when officially assigned as a participating member of a fire fighting crew on the fireline in fighting fires of equipment, installation, buildings, or forests and ranges.


CONDITIONS FOR PAYMENT

Overheight Pay - Employees while working on transmission line structures (including wood pole structures), microwave towers, or other towers, shall be paid at two times the straight time rate of pay when they are required to climb 80 feet or more above the ground.

Employees while working suspended free of a structure on any conductor, at any height, shall be paid two times the straight time rate of pay.
