Remedy 14673	<p>Summary: During Patch 50 an SCR 02-2830-DOD was produced giving the System Administrators the capability to delete RPAs. There was a problem with the initial fielding (identified in PR 14395, Patch 50.8). The solution for 14395 contained a bug (nulled out the altered pa request id of cancellations and corrections) that was discovered during research of the first PARIS performance problem reported in PR 14510. The bug from 14395 was corrected and a script was produced to correct the data condition that was causing the PARIS interface to go into a loop, PR 14510 was fielded in Patch 50.10.1. CPMS has provided a final spreadsheet of those RPAs that either need to be deleted or re-linked back to the originating RPAs.</p> <p>Resolution: Changed the data fix script so that it does the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Re-link corrections and cancellation RPAs to originating RPAs based on PA Request Ids provided by CPMS. 2. Delete RPAs that have a status of 'UPDATE_HR_COMPLETE' based on PA Request Ids provided by CPMS. 3. Delete RPAs that have a status other than 'UPDATE_HR_COMPLETE' based on PA Request Ids provided by CPMS. 4. Re-link correction for a dual action that had both actions corrected and then cancelled based on PA Request Ids provided by CPMS 	CPMS	Other

These reports should default to all SOIDs if a specific single SOID is not input as a parameter and print should be distributed to each of the individual SOIDs. Remedy 16874	<p>Summary: The first manpower interface run was executed via Concurrent Manager, process name Process Manpower Table Update (System Administrator). Although the Request Log states the process completed successfully, it did not process all of the records in the interface file. Upon further investigation it was determined that the process encountered a position record that was assigned to two different people at the same time. At this point in time, the process aborted.</p> <p>Resolution: Modified the manpower interface code so that whenever it encounters an error while inserting/updating a record, it records it in the process log under program name 'MPWR-RUN' and continues processing. Also modified the code so that if there was a problem inserting a record into the DCPDS Manpower table, the record that had the error is recorded in the process log.</p>	CPMS	External Interfaces
Remedy 16908	<p>Summary: Rcvd error on Position variables for Payroll Interface CIV_PAYROLL_500_1.</p> <p>Production: In this package the variable was declared as character size 5. The actual data length is passing to this variable is more than 5 characters and was causing the problem. All the rejected records will have position description number more than 5 characters in length. Increased the length of the variable from 5 to 20 characters. This will fix the problem.
