RPA populates incorrect locality for LEOs PT 0491 with PRD 6.</p> <p><b>Resolution:</b> LEO pay calculations have been modified as follows: if the LEO Indicator is 1 or 2, then the employee is entitled to a full Locality percentage increase. Second, if the LEO pay area contains a LEO Pay Area Code, attempt to use the LEO locality percentage. Third, if no LEO locality percentage is available, then use the Assignment's locality percentage.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Oracle TAR 3476187.996 and Oracle TAR 3589763.999</p> | CPMS         | PAY               |
| Remedy 15562          | <p><b>Summary:</b> Deselection in Mass Salary was not working. A894 (for NAF Mass Salary) processed deselected records also.</p> <p><b>Resolution:</b> Employee can now be deselected in mass salary, and the deselection remains in force after the user closes the mass salary screen. Now the user's de-selected employees will be saved in the mass salary and not included in the Execution of the mass salary</p> <p><b>Note:</b> TAR 3611552.999/ (Bug 3337361)</p>   | CPMS         | PAY               |

**Summary:** Mass Salary was requiring at least one additional selection criteria from Organization, personnel office ID, agency code, or subelement code.

**Resolution:** Requirement for additional selection criteria removed. Now when creating a Mass Salary, users will be required to only enter Name, Pay Table ID, Effective Date, Pay Plan and Pay Rate Determinant. NOTE: Performance of the Mass Salary Execute routine is improved when at least one Additional Selection Criteria data items has been entered.
