SUBJECT: Authorized Departure – Havana, Cuba



Effective October 19, 2005, the Department of State (DoS) approved an authorized departure of Eligible Family Members (EFMs) and Non-Emergency Personnel for the US Interest Section in Havana, Cuba. The DoS has designated CONUS as the safe haven location.

This departure status has been approved for an initial period of seven days and will remain in effect thereafter until terminated. Family members who leave under this authority may not return until the authorized departure is terminated.

Stop Movement. Travel to Havana for all DoD dependent personnel in all categories is hereby suspended. This authority remains in effect until the authorized departure is terminated. An exception to this stop movement order may be requested and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Dependents of uniformed personnel will be processed for safe haven allowances in accordance with Chapter 6, Part A of the JFTR. Eligible DoD civilians and EFMs will be processed as indicated in JTR, Chapter 12, Appendix I.
