SUBJECT: Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Special Wage Rate Ranges – San Diego, California
Wage Area #054

This letter amends the regular Wage Schedule #022 for the San Diego, California wage area in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management letter dated April 29, 2005, which authorized special rate ranges for certain skilled trades positions. The special rate ranges shown below have been established under the authority of DoD Directive 5120.42 "Department of Defense Wage Fixing Authority – Nonappropriated Fund Compensation Programs," and 5 CFR 532.251 and 532.253.

These special rate ranges are authorized for **Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton** for grades NA-8, NA-9, NA-10, and NA-11 in the following occupational series: Air Conditioning Equipment Mechanic, 5306; Carpenter, 4607; Electrician, 2805; Maintenance Mechanic, 4749; Painter, 4102; Plumber, 4206. Special rates are also authorized for the corresponding leader and supervisory positions.

These special rate ranges conform with limitations contained in CPM 2006-18, dated December 21, 2006. The effective date is November 10, 2006. The order date for the 2006 wage survey was September 5, 2006.

The special rates amendment will expire when the next survey-based regular schedule is issued. In order to continue the authorization, affected components are required to comply with the provisions of Subchapter S12-6b of the OPM Operating Manual – Federal Wage System, Nonappropriated Fund.



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
