MISSISSIPPI WAGE AREA

SUBJECT: Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Special Wage Rate Ranges - Harrison, Mississippi  
Wage Area #070

This letter amends the regular Wage Schedule #019 for the Harrison, Mississippi wage area in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management letter dated November 29, 2001, which authorized a special rate range for the position of Custodial Worker (NA-3566-02). The special rate ranges shown below have been established under the authority of DoD Directive 5120.42 "Department of Defense Wage Fixing Authority – Nonappropriated Fund Compensation Programs," and 5 CFR 532.251 and 532.253.

These special ranges are authorized for the Keesler AFB Services Squadron, Keesler Base Exchange, Morale, Welfare and Recreation Division - Naval Construction Battalion Center (NCBC), and Navy Exchange - NCBC.

In conformance with CPM 2003-1, dated January 23, 2003, these new rates are restricted to a 3.1% maximum over current rates. The effective date is December 6, 2002. The order date for the 2002 wage survey was October 1, 2002.

The special rates amendment will expire when the next regular survey-based regular schedule is issued. In order to continue the authorization, the affected components are required to comply with the provisions of Subchapter S12-6b of the OPM Operating Manual – Federal Wage System, Nonappropriated Fund.
