MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDING OFFICERS OF MILITARY DEPARTMENTS AND
DOD COMPONENT INSTALLATIONS IN THE EL PASO,
COLORADO WAGE AREA

SUBJECT: Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Special Wage Rate Ranges – El Paso, Colorado
Wage Area #085

This letter amends the regular Wage Schedule #014 for the El Paso, Colorado wage area in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management letter dated November 6, 2000, which authorized special rate ranges for Custodial Worker, NA-3566-01 and NA-3566-02. The special rate ranges shown below have been established under the authority of DoD Directive 5120.42 “Department of Defense Wage Fixing Authority – Nonappropriated Fund Compensation Programs,” and 5 CFR 532.251 and 532.253.

These special ranges are authorized for the Services Squadron at Peterson AFB, the Services Squadron at the USAF Academy, MWR activities at Fort Carson, and MWR activities at Pueblo Chemical Depot. These special ranges supersede increased minimum rates for Custodial Worker positions at Peterson AFB, the USAF Academy, and Fort Carson.

The effective date of these rates is the first day of the first pay period beginning on or after the issue date of this letter. The special rates amendment will expire when the next regular survey-based regular schedule is issued. In order to continue the authorization, affected components are required to comply with the provisions of Subchapter S12-6b of the OPM Operating Manual – Federal Wage System, Nonappropriated Fund.
