ALASKA WAGE AREA

SUBJECT: Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Special Wage Rate Ranges- Anchorage, Alaska
Wage Area #118

This letter amends the regular Wage Schedule #018 for the Anchorage, Alaska wage area in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management letters dated June 7, 1996 and September 13, 2002, which authorized special rate ranges for Small Craft Operator and Marine Engine Mechanic. The special rate ranges shown below have been established under the authority of DoD Directive 5120.42 "Department of Defense Wage Fixing Authority – Nonappropriated Fund Compensation Programs," and 5 CFR 532.251 and 532.253.
