SUBJECT: Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Special Wage Rate Ranges - Dallas, Texas  
Wage Area #152

This letter amends the regular Wage Schedules #020 for the Dallas, Texas wage area in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management letter dated July 6, 1982, which authorized special rate ranges for Air Conditioning Equipment Mechanic positions. The special rate ranges shown below have been established under the authority of DoD Directive 5120.42 "Department of Defense Wage Fixing Authority – Nonappropriated Fund Compensation Programs," and 5 CFR.
