Voltage Electricians, WG, WL, and WS-2810-10, in the
New London, Connecticut Wage Area.

Rates or Rate Ranges Under the Federal Wage System.


(c) DoD Civilian Personnel Advisory Service letter, dated
3 February 2014, Subject: Federal Wage System Regular and Special
Production Facilitating Wage Rate Schedules (AC-025) for the New London,
Connecticut Wage Area.

The rates shown below have been established under authority of DoD Instruction
5120.39, dated September 10, 2008, subject to the limitations contained in CPM 2014-02,
dated January 27, 2014, and are to be applied in accordance with references (a) and (b)
above. The Federal Wage System Regular and Special Production Facilitating Wage Rate
Schedules for the Wage Area of New London, Connecticut (reference (c)) are amended to
provide the following special rates for the High Voltage Electrician positions located at
the Naval Submarine Base New London in Groton, CT:

High Voltage Electrician	WG-2810-10	\$30.11
High Voltage Electrician Leader	WL-2810-10	\$32.82
High Voltage Electrician Supervisory	WS-2810-10	\$38.09

This authorization is effective on November 17, 2013.
