SUBJECT: Federal Wage System Special Wage Rates for Electrical Lineman Positions in the Boston, Massachusetts Wage Area

TO: Commanding Officers of Military Departments and DoD Component Installations in the Wage Area

REFERENCES: (a) U.S. Civil Service Commission, Bureau of Policies and Standards letter, dated August 22, 1978, to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Civilian Personnel Policy) which authorized the establishment of Special Rates for Electrical Lineman Positions in the Boston, Massachusetts Wage Area.

(b) 5 CFR Part 532.


(c) DoD Civilian Personnel Advisory Service letter, dated February 3, 2014, Subject: Federal Wage System Regular and Special Production Facilitating Wage Rate Schedules (AC-068) for the Boston, Massachusetts Wage Area.

The rates shown below have been established under authority of DoD Instruction 5120.39, dated September 10, 2008, subject to the limitations contained in CPM 2014-02, dated January 27, 2014, and are to be applied in accordance with references (a) and (b) above. The Federal Wage System Regular and Special Production Facilitating Wage Rate Schedules for the Boston, Massachusetts Wage Area (reference (c)) are amended to provide the following special rates for "Electrical Lineman" positions:

<i>Occupation</i>	<i>Grades</i>	<i>Hourly Rates</i>
Electrician (High Voltage)	WG-10	\$28.18
Electrician (High Voltage) Leader	WL-10	\$30.68
Electrician (High Voltage) Foreman	WS-09	\$34.84
Electrician (High Voltage) Foreman	WS-10	\$35.86

NOTE: These rates apply to nonsupervisory, leader, and directly related supervisory positions whose work involves the installation, test, repair, and maintenance of overhead and underground primary electrical distribution systems (formerly classified in the Electrical Line Working series prior to the issuance of FWS job grading standards for Electrician (High Voltage)). They do not apply to positions whose work solely involves the repair and maintenance of electric generators, transformers, regulators, and other circuitry elements found in electric power plants and substations (formerly classified in the Electrical Working (Powerhouse) series prior to the issuance of FWS job grading standards for Electrician (High Voltage)).

Request that a report of application showing the number of employees, by grade and title, paid from this schedule be forwarded to the Chief, Wage and Salary Branch, Defense Civilian Personnel Advisory Service, Suite 05G21, 4800 Mark Center Drive, Alexandria, VA 22350-1100, not later than two weeks after implementation.
