Duties: Plans, organizes, and directs fire protection activities within the goals and objectives of the Theater Campaign Plan and direction of the Fire Chief. Conduct fire safety assessments and inspections missions at outlying Forward Operating Bases (FOBs) semi-annually at each location. Provides analyses of fire protection operations, determines trends and problems, and formulates corrective measures. Provides fire protection guidance as requested and coordinates fire protection support agreements and pre-incident plans. Executes and enforces the USFOR-A Fire Policies In Accordance With (IAW) Army Regulation (AR) 420-1 and Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 6055.6. Conducts and evaluates training on specialized fire protection equipment and procedures. Provides fire prevention guidance and performs project reviews to ensure fire safety feature adequacy. Inspects facilities, and identifies fire hazards and deficiencies. Determines fire extinguisher distribution requirements and performs inspections and maintenance. Established public relations and conducts fire prevention awareness and educational training. Investigate fires to determine origin and cause. Acts as the Fire Chief in the absence of and at meetings, briefing and events as assigned.
